

## Saber Junction 22 MRA Concept and Usage

The MRA for the Saber Junction (SJ) 22 Exercise is intended to support the following functions or activities:

1. The placement of inflatable targets intended for attack helicopters to find and engage to the West of the training area. The helicopters will not use live ammunition for this.
2. To support recurring tactical and logistical movements in support of the exercise.
3. To allow the tactical movement of convoys between Grafenwoehr Training Area (GTA) and Hohenfels Training Area (HTA).
4. To allow the use of DZ Torque to the west of HTA for the Airborne Insertion of approximately 102 Soldiers and for those Soldiers to move into the training area via Gate 6 (Emhof).
5. To provide space for the BDE to set up its TOC in the MRA East of HTA
6. To allow 4-319 FAR to set up its howitzers for a few hours east of HTA to provide cover for the air drop
7. To allow small reconnaissance elements to include Belgian Army units to conduct reconnaissance missions to the immediate west of HTA
8. To allow the BDE to conduct a "GAC (Ground Assault Convoy) from GTA to HTA at the beginning of the exercise (7-9 September)

The heaviest vehicle will be an LHS with trailer

There will be approximately 150 Belgian Soldiers participating in the MRA.
